Families of Slain Children, Inc. (FOSCI) invite you and your Teen(s) to register to participate in our Teens on TRAC (Teens Racing Against Violent Crimes) Program.

The Teens On Trac Program will consist of a 12-week Growth, Development and Leadership training designed to educate students between the ages of (13-18) who have been exposed to violent crimes directly impacting their lives in the areas of decision making, health, education, finances and relationships. The program will help to facilitate peer-to-peer prevention, advocacy against teen violence, accepting personal responsibility, creating and developing a life plan, resolving conflict and committing to goals and dreams.

After successfully registering into the program, Teen(s) will attend classes to learn and understand the formula for Personal Motivation [Value (my life) x Expectation (for a better life) = Motivation (for fulfilling personal dreams)]. In addition, students will be given opportunities to connect with business and government managers, educators, and law enforcement to explore ways to get involved in neighborhood improvement projects. Also, students will learn how to become collaborators at FOSCI community events and participate in service projects to gain awareness, education, and prevention strategies designed to help eliminate violent crimes in their communities.

To register for the Teens on TRAC program, contact FOSCI, Inc. headquarters located at 2212 N. Myrtle Ave., Jacksonville, FL 32209. An official notification will be sent with the orientation schedule. Parents/Guardian and Teen(s) must attend orientation. Unless otherwise noted, all sessions will be held at FOSCI, Inc.
